The Task Forces include two-three engines for water supply. The Strike Teams consist of at least five tankers from each section (North, Center, South and [West]). The tankers included on the teams are dump-type tankers only. As new apparatus is delivered they will be added to the appropriate teams and task forces by region.

Command – Task Force and Strike Team Leaders

A Task Force (and Strike Team) Leader should be appointed when a Task Force (and/ or Strike Team) is deployed. This will make communications with the Incident Commander and incident management easier with single points of contact for the teams responding. The TFL will be this point of contact with the IC as the team responds and then integrates into the incident upon arrival. These team leaders should have tanker operations and water supply experience.

Requesting a Task Force or Strike Team

An Incident Commander can request a Task Force if a water supply has not been established (or an additional supply is required). A Strike Team(s) can be requested if only mobile water supply apparatus are required with an established water supply.

The Tanker Task Forces and Strike Teams can be requested through QV Dispatch (as part of the State Fire-Rescue Plan). An operational frequency should be designated for the responding units.

Additional Regional Units

A Western team will consist of Windham area apparatus and the Southern team will be blended with the northern New London County apparatus based on the NL County plan.
